Sandra,

Thank you for your advice during our conference call today. We requested clarification regarding activities allowed in the Anti Human Trafficking grant (Grant No. ZH09010380). The issue was whether the grant would allow the San Francisco Police Department to conduct enforcement operations not outlined in the application. The application proposed undercover investigations and permit investigations; however, SFPD is now proposing aggressive street enforcement of a more general nature in response to complaints of prostitution in a particular neighborhood.

You supported the proposed activity as it still addresses the broad program goals, and the program allows modifications to address the evolving needs of a jurisdiction. Thank you very much for your support. Please confirm that I have accurately summarized your response.
